WHAT PARENTS/GUARDIANS NEED TO KNOW

Sign in

- Campers may not be signed in prior to 7:45 a.m. unless you have previously signed up for before care.
- If a camper is going to arrive later than 8:00 a.m. the parent/guardian must inform the camp counselor
 of this the day before.
- A parent/guardian must accompany the camper to the camp and sign them in with a counselor.
- Campers will be expected to have all items needed for the day as listed below. Counselors may ask to show the counselor that they have all necessary items upon arrival. If it is discovered after the parent/guardian leaves that a camper does not have the necessary items a parent/guardian will be called and will be expected to bring the necessary items to camp.

Sign Out

- Camp ends at 4:00 p.m. and unless campers have been previously signed up for after care they should be picked up no later than 4:10 p.m.
- When picking up their camper from camp a parent/guardian must make contact with a counselor and sign their camper out.
- Only people listed on the camper's registration form under Parent/Guardian and Authorized Pickup and Emergency Contact will be allow to sign out the camper.
- If a counselor does not recognize the person picking up a camper they will request a photo ID and confirm that the person is authorized to pick up the camper.
- Changes to the Parent/Guardian and Authorized Pickup and Emergency Contact list must be made in person by the parent/guardian to the front office.

What to bring/wear to camp - PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT ALL ITEMS/CLOTHING ARE CLEARLY MARKED WITH YOUR CAMPER'S FIRST AND LAST NAME.

- Healthy snacks and lunch pack food in a well insulated container or cooler with your child first and last name on it. There is no refrigerator available for snack/lunch storage.
- Snack breaks will be planned throughout the day so please make sure you pack plenty of snacks.
- Refillable water bottle although water will be available to refill the bottles throughout the day we ask that the campers arrive with their bottles filled ready to start the day.
- Sunscreen PLEASE apply sunscreen in the morning before your camper arrives. Campers must have sunscreen with them to apply throughout the day (spray sunscreen is best). Counselors will not apply sunscreen but will remind the campers to do so throughout the day.
- Towel- campers will have the opportunity to swim each day and may play games that include water.
- Clothing and footwear campers should dress in comfortable play cloths such as t-shirts, shorts or pants. To protect the campers from the sun we require shirts that cover the their shoulders as opposed to sleeveless shirts or tank tops. Weather permitting, campers will swim each day so please have them bring properly fitting bathing suits. We highly encourage sneakers so that campers may freely run and play although sandals with back straps that will allow campers to freely run are also permitted. Crocs and flip flops will not be allowed. We also recommend packing an extra change of clothes.
- Campers should NOT bring any electronic devices, toys or games to camp.
