Now in its 80th year, Catholic Charities New Hampshire continues to demonstrate how powerful and impactful its presence is. Through their work, our poor and vulnerable neighbors are lifted and empowered. You are the strength and compassion behind that good work, and I am grateful for all you do in service to our Lord and His people here in New Hampshire.

Hannah's Journey of Growth

Hannah looked out the window as the flowers bloomed in the garden.

The vibrant petals signaled renewal – just like the renewal Hannah found in her journey out of homelessness, made possible by your support.

Hannah has lived with autism her entire life, viewing the world through her unique lens, shaped by her deep Christian faith. Her greatest joy was becoming a mother to her two children, Charlie and Isabel, finding happiness in her growing family.

But when tensions arose, their home was no longer safe. With courage, Hannah decided to protect her children, even if it meant leaving them without a home. The uncertainty was overwhelming – until she found New Generation.

The Catholic Charities NH program provides safe shelter and support services, helping mothers like Hannah overcome homelessness and rebuild their lives.

With their help, Hannah found hope. She gained parenting, financial and life skills that would set her up

for success. New Generation's staff helped her find early education for her children and secure stable housing. The staff's expert guidance and support enabled her to heal emotionally and regain physical health amid a series of medical issues.

Three months after moving into New Generation, Hannah unlocked the door to their new apartment.

Charlie and Isabel finally had their own beds to sleep in. Hannah could make the kids' favorite homemade pizzas. The family had a safe, stable place to call home, grow, and make cherished memories.

Without the generosity of people like you, Hannah's story might have ended differently.

“Last year, my life felt like it was built on a foundation of broken rocks,” she shared. “But now, New Generation and its supporters poured the concrete for the solid foundation beneath me that I can build my life upon. Every donation sows seeds of change, turning dreams into possibilities for me and other mothers like me.”

Roberta's Peace of Mind

Snow fell and the wind howled as the power went out, leaving Roberta's small rural home in darkness.

Then, the phone rang.

On the other end was a Monadnock at Home volunteer, a familiar and welcome voice: *"Are you okay, Roberta? Do you need anything?"*

Now in her mid-80s, Roberta describes herself as highly independent and self-reliant. But neurological issues have impacted her mobility. She uses a walker, but everyday tasks – like carrying groceries or filling the backyard bird feeder – are now difficult.

She came across Monadnock at Home, the Catholic Charities NH program that helps older adults like Roberta avoid isolation and stay in their homes. At first, she only expected occasional help around the house, but the program has become a true lifeline for her.

Roberta was able to find a housekeeper to tidy her home, a gardener to tend her yard, and volunteers to make daily life safer and easier. They've added handrails, fixed the lights around the home, and even built her a cart to carry groceries up her steps. When she needs a ride to the doctor's office – more than an hour away – they're there for her.

For Roberta, this isn't just help. In a world where aging often brings uncertainty, Monadnock at Home has given her security, dignity, and connection. With community support, she can keep living independently at home.

"My whole quality of life is great because of Monadnock at Home," she shares. "They have given me peace of mind I otherwise wouldn't have without them. Because of them, I can access everything I need!"

Overcoming Life's Toughest Tests – Joanne's Story

Joanne is not one to back down from life's toughest tests. Her strength and resilience are rooted in love and selfless actions for others.

At 67, she's no stranger to hardship. After a car accident left her with lasting physical disabilities and a long battle with addiction took a toll, Joanne is now sober and grateful for life's simple pleasures.

But then came another test.

Her daughter, struggling with her own addiction, could no longer care for Joanne's two grandchildren. Without hesitation, Joanne opened her arms and welcomed the two boys, determined to give them the love and stability they desperately needed.

Every weekday, Joanne drives 80 miles round-trip so her youngest grandchild can attend a school that meets his special needs. She's always there on time, sending him off with a loving hug and greeting him with a warm smile at pickup.

But even the strongest among us can stumble. As winter approached, it became a struggle to meet basic needs. Joanne fell behind on her utility bill and could not afford heating oil. "I was exhausted, without much hope," she reflects on that difficult time.

Then she called Catholic Charities NH. Our Community Services team sprang into action, reviewing her financial situation and arranging for donor-supported emergency fuel assistance – 100 gallons of heating oil to warm her home. We also connected her with local resources to further ensure her family's warmth in the months to come.

Joanne is grateful to Catholic Charities NH donors for lifting her spirits and helping her through a difficult time. Your support didn't just heat a home – it restored hope for a woman who has given everything for others.

Joanne's story – and the support hundreds of others receive through Community Services – is made possible in part by the Diocesan New Hampshire Catholic Appeal (NHCA). NHCA funds cover about 80% of this program's costs. Other Catholic Charities NH programs, such as Liberty House and New Generation, are funded through separate appeals conducted by Catholic Charities' annual fundraising efforts. The NHCA is not part of a Catholic Charities fundraising campaign. CCNH is grateful for the support it receives from the NHCA.



Ernesto's Attitude of Service for Seniors

As Ernesto Pinder places the last bag of groceries in his truck and closes the gate, he tips his cowboy hat back and smiles. He knows the next couple of hours will bring more than food to the seniors he's about to visit. His presence will also bring connection, compassion, and comfort.

A long-time volunteer with CareGivers' Caring Cupboard program, Ernesto delivers monthly groceries to homebound older adults facing food insecurity. It's a reality he knows all too well. Growing up in a single-parent home, food was often scarce.

"There was more month than money," he says. "We relied on food pantries to get by. So, this isn't just volunteering for me, it's personal."

Each month, Ernesto delivers vital nutrition, as well as moments of presence and joy for seniors like Janine, who lives alone and rarely leaves home – but lights up when Ernesto visits.

"For some, I might be the only person they see that day," he says. "It's a privilege to be part of that moment."

Each delivery is a reminder of what he calls an "attitude of service," a mindset that looks beyond inconvenience and toward making a positive impact.

"Whatever we have going on, someone else has it harder," he says. "We can't wait to help, we have to do what we can today."

Thanks to generous donors who make programs like CareGivers possible, Ernesto can step into this role of service and hope. And for the seniors like Janine who open their doors to his smile, warm words and heavy grocery bags, his presence is a lifeline.

Breaking Ground on Vose Farm Residences

In October, Catholic Charities NH broke ground on Vose Farm Residences, a 96-unit mixed-income housing development in Peterborough. This milestone project will offer modern apartments, shared community spaces, and on-site supportive services to help residents overcome challenges and build self-sufficiency. Vose Farm is a significant first step in our efforts to address the housing crisis and strengthen communities across New Hampshire.

Warde Senior Living in Windham achieved four deficiency-free ratings in surveys from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services and the NH Department of Health & Human Services. This is an extraordinary accomplishment reflecting outstanding care, safety, and service at Warde Assisted Living and Warde Rehabilitation & Nursing Center.

St. Ann Rehabilitation & Nursing Center in Dover also earned a deficiency-free rating from the NH Department of Health & Human Services, marking the fourth time in five years. These honors reflect our staff's unwavering commitment to compassionate, high-quality care for every resident.

National Recognition for St. Ann and Mt. Carmel

St. Ann Rehabilitation & Nursing Center in Dover and Mt. Carmel Rehabilitation & Nursing Center in Manchester were both named a Best Nursing Home for short-term rehabilitation by U.S. News & World Report for 2025, earning top scores in safety, staffing, infection prevention, and successful patient outcomes.

Our rehabilitation services focus on post-hospital recovery, offering personalized care and therapy to help patients regain strength and independence. This honor is a testament to the clinical expertise and deep commitment our teams bring to each patient's recovery journey.



You Created A Lasting Impact – Across New Hampshire

Because of you, Catholic Charities NH programs transformed thousands of lives across New Hampshire this year. Your support provided the essential resources and guidance needed to help individuals and families overcome their darkest days and build bright, promising futures.

You gave struggling veterans back their dignity and purpose – Liberty House

- 5,313 collective nights of shelter provided through Liberty House's transitional housing program.
- 49,478 items of food, clothing, and other basic needs distributed through Liberty House's community pantry.

You helped families keep the heat on, stay housed, and avoid falling further into poverty – Community Services

- 9,543 household members benefited from case management, financial assistance and compassionate, comprehensive support.
- 26,364 collective days of safe housing preserved for individuals and families through energy/fuel, electricity, and shelter assistance.

You helped ensure homebound seniors weren't left hungry or forgotten - CareGivers

- 122,885 pounds of food, equivalent to 102,400 meals, delivered through Caring Cupboard.
- 16,977 miles driven by volunteers to take older adults to the doctor, the grocery store and other essential appointments through Caring Rides.
- 498 seniors received the care and connection they need to age with dignity.



You made healing possible for those carrying emotional pain and difficult life situations – Mental Health Counseling Services

- 2,064 counseling sessions provided to individuals, couples and families.
- \$258,000 in charitable care provided through our sliding-scale service.

You gave families facing homelessness a roof, a bed, and a fresh start - New Generation

- 7,127 nights of safe shelter provided for families.
- 177 mothers and children received support to build stable lives and eventually secure housing.

You gave small children a safe place to grow, and their parents the tools to guide them – Our Place

- 130 children benefited from the pregnancy and parenting education their parents received.
- 97% of parents improved their parenting and child development knowledge.

Your Impact Went Even Further

Over the past year, more people turned to Catholic Charities NH for help – and because of you, we were able to answer the call:

- 47% increase in habitable housing days preserved through heating fuel assistance provided by Community Services.
- 43% increase in families provided with New Generation's stabilization services, preventing the recurrence of homelessness.
- 44% increase in household members who received financial assistance through Community Services.
- 17% increase in total case filings, via Immigration Legal Services, helping more families stay safe and united.
- 11% increase in food, clothing and other basic needs assistance distributed to community veterans at Liberty House.
- 9% more nights of safe shelter for mothers and children at New Generation.




