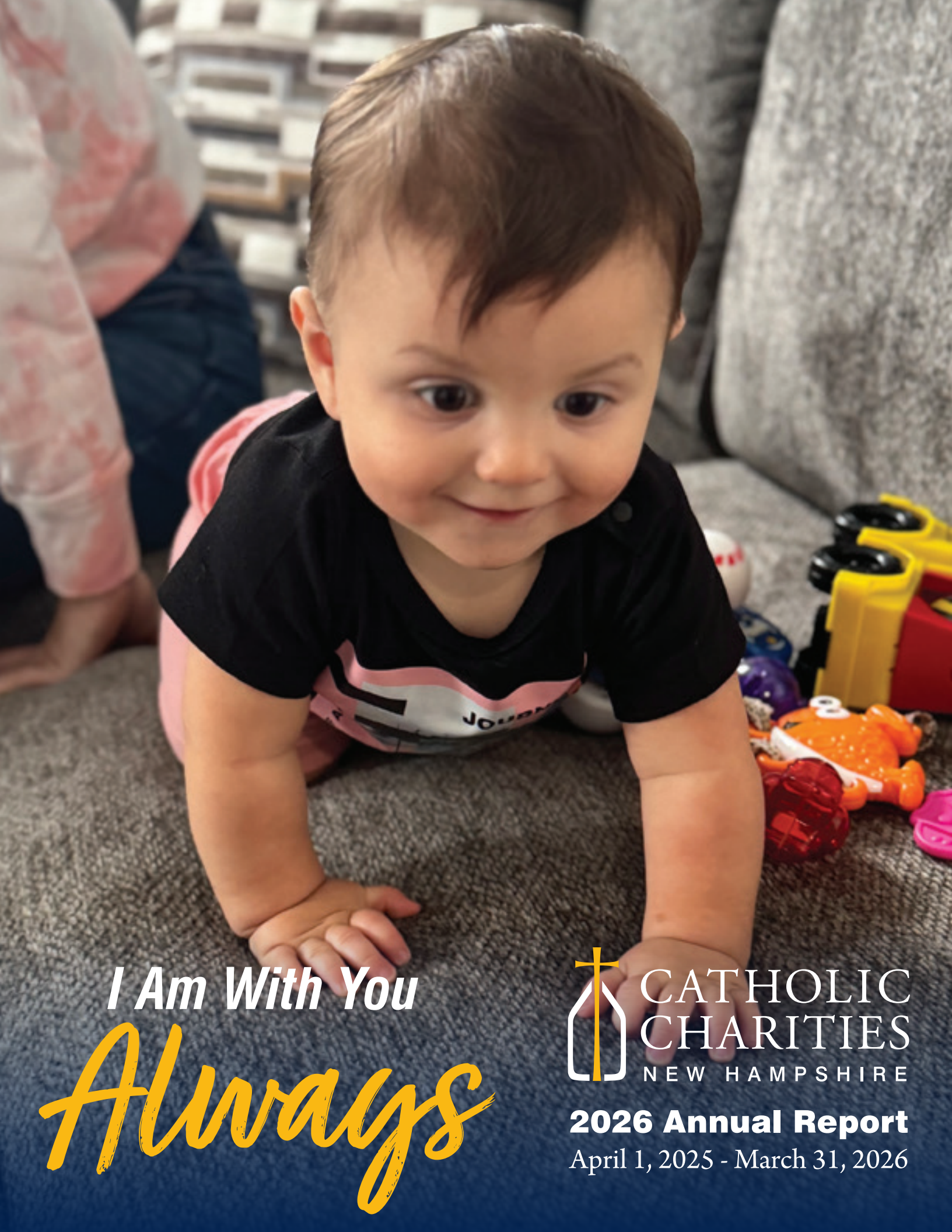

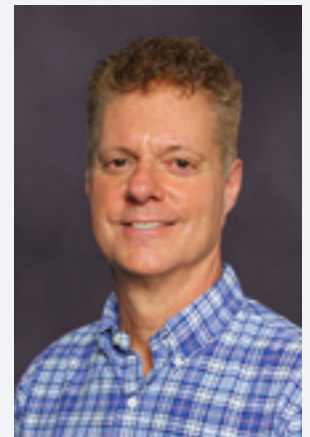

Those words offer comfort in life's hardest moments. They remind us that no one should have to face struggle, uncertainty, or hardship alone. Every day, because of caring supporters like you, that promise comes to life for our neighbors who need it most.

Take Tammy, for instance. You were there when, at just 16, she gave birth to her first child with no one to rely on. Through your support, she gained the skills and confidence to become the mother she is today. Decades later, when a debilitating stroke turned her life upside down, you were there again – helping her regain her independence and providing the food, transportation and human connection she needs to live with dignity.



When a mother sits at her kitchen table wondering how she'll keep the lights on for her children, your compassion is there. We recently met a mom who was working hard to provide for her family but was overwhelmed by rising costs and unexpected bills. With assistance and support from CCHH staff, she was able to keep her utilities connected, maintain stability for her children, and focus on building a brighter future. In a moment when she felt alone, our community stood beside her.

When recovery feels impossible, your support is there. One single mom fought every day to overcome addiction and rebuild her life. The journey was long and difficult, but she never gave up. With guidance, resources, and encouragement, she achieved sobriety, regained custody of her son, and began creating the stable, loving home they deserved.

And when a family dares to dream of a place to truly call home, your reinforcement is there. Today, that same mom and her little boy are no longer moving from place to place or wondering where they'll sleep next. They have a home of their own, a safe space where memories are being made, brighter futures are unfolding, and hope is growing every day.

These stories are different, but they share one thing in common: someone chose to walk alongside them. That's the power of your generosity. It says to a struggling parent, *"I will be with you always."* It says to a senior facing isolation, *"I will be with you always."* It says to a family working to heal and rebuild, *"I will be with you always."*

Together, we are creating a community where people are not defined by their challenges, but strengthened by the support they receive and the hope they (re)discover. Thank you for being the steady presence that helps our neighbors move from crisis to stability, from isolation to connection, and from uncertainty to possibility. Because of you, they are not alone.

Allegra's New Purpose – And a Place to Call Home

Allegra stood in her new kitchen, soaking in a moment she once thought impossible.

Nearby, her 10-month-old son, Theon, crawled across the floor, giggling with joy. For the first time in a long time, everything felt safe and calm.

Just seven months earlier, Allegra and Theon were homeless. Now, she can tuck her son into his own bed, in a place they can finally call home.

And it's all because of you – and the support you provide through our New Generation program.

Allegra grew up in the North Country and enjoyed a stable childhood. After high school, she had a good job, a long-term boyfriend, and a simple life.

But at 33, everything changed.

Allegra got caught up in the local drug scene, lost her job and license, and found herself trapped in a cycle of sobriety and relapse.

"I was drifting through life, without a purpose," she shared.

When Allegra became pregnant with Theon, DCYF gave her a choice: enter treatment, or lose custody of her son.

She chose treatment.

After four months at a recovery center, she completed the program, but had nowhere to go next.

Then she found New Generation.

With support from staff, she graduated from an intensive outpatient program, got her driver's license, found childcare, and applied for housing.

Two months later, the call came. A two-bedroom apartment was available.

They moved in a few months ago.

Now sober for more than a year, Allegra's purpose is clear.

"I want to keep Theon happy and provide a good home for him, making sure he grows up with a good set of morals and values," she shared.

Looking ahead, she hopes to return to school and pursue a career in graphic design.

Your support opened doors for Allegra and Theon, giving them the opportunity to build a safe, stable life together.

Your support provided **6,665 collective nights of shelter** for mothers and children like Allegra and Theon over the past year, giving families a safe place to turn when they had nowhere else to go.



You Helped Jimmy Rebuild The Life He Thought He'd Lost

Jimmy's phone rang with devastating news. His mother had died in the July 2025 fire at an assisted living facility in Fall River, MA.

As Jimmy worked to stay sober, it was a moment that could have broken him. But because of you, Jimmy didn't face it alone.

Liberty House staff and fellow veteran residents were there to guide Jimmy through his grief and remind him that hope was possible.

"I would not have been able to stay sober if I didn't have this place," he says about the Catholic Charities program that provides transitional housing and support for veterans.

Growing up, Jimmy idolized his uncle, a World War II veteran. When the Gulf War began, he joined the Army Reserve, serving a total of 14 years.

Service also became his career. Over three decades, Jimmy worked as a firefighter, paramedic, and police officer. But the weight of those years piled up silently.

"You see a lot of things every day and you don't realize you're packing it all into your head," he says.

What started as drinking after shifts cost him his marriage, his relationship with his four children, and eventually his home.

"I needed to change – for them and for myself."

After retiring in 2023, Jimmy made significant progress. But when the sobriety center where he lived unexpectedly closed, he found himself with nowhere to go.

"I told them I had nothing, I had to start over," he recalls his call to Liberty House. "Five days later, they called and said, 'You're in.' And I said, 'You just saved my life.'"

At Liberty House, Jimmy secured benefits, learned to budget, found a job with the American Red Cross, reconnected with his children, and eventually moved into permanent housing.

This past November, Jimmy celebrated two full years of sobriety.

Your support gave Jimmy the sense of community, the opportunity to reconnect with his family, and the path to a stable life.

Tears of Joy: Your Generosity Delivers for Carol

Carol opened her kitchen cabinet and froze.

Only a few cans remained. Nothing was fresh. She wasn't sure where tomorrow's meals would come from.

She whispered to herself, "Please... let them come today."

Then came the knock.

Thanks to you, a smiling Caring Cupboard volunteer stood at Carol's door holding two big bags of groceries – real food she hadn't seen in weeks.

"I never cried so hard in my life," she recalls. "I felt so blessed."

Carol once lived a stable life with a great job, but declining health and a recent hospital stay left her homebound on a fixed income. She struggled to reach the grocery store and could only afford one meal a day.

Despite her own challenges, she didn't hesitate to open her home and become a caregiver when her sister needed her.

"I'd give my life for my sister," she says. "But it's hard when you know you don't have enough."

And that's where you came in.

Your generosity didn't just bring groceries to Carol. It also brought relief and dignity.

Each delivery means Carol doesn't have to choose between medication and dinner. It means she and her sister can eat full meals, not scraps. It means she feels seen, supported, and no longer alone.

"It's scary to think you'll have to go without eating," Carol says. "We eat every bit of the food they bring. I love the people who deliver and I am so grateful to the people who give. Thank you."

Because of you, Carol has peace of mind that comes from knowing there will be food on the table tomorrow.

125,230 pounds of food were delivered to homebound older adults like Carol, helping ensure they had enough nutritious food to eat.



When Fear Took Over, You Gave Sabrina and Her Boys Hope

Sabrina closed her eyes, trembling, waiting to see if the lights would stay on.

She never imagined life would come to this. A mother of two young boys, Sabrina worked full-time and did everything right to provide for her kids. Still, making ends meet felt impossible.

First came the divorce. Then the child support payments stopped. Then her father – the one person she could truly rely on – passed away.

Grief set in. So did fear.

Sabrina picked up extra shifts at work to stretch every dollar she had. But the bills still piled up. Each morning began with the same worry: Would today be the day the electricity was shut off?

Sabrina had always been the one there for others through tough times. Never did she imagine she would be the one asking for help.

That's when generous people like you stepped in.

When Sabrina called Catholic Charities NH, our Community Services team took the time to understand her situation and identify solutions. Together, we connected her with a local assistance program to help with some of the bills, reviewed her Section 8 housing application, and guided her to take important steps toward long-term stability.

We also helped her create a budget for the first time, allowing her to manage expenses while waiting for benefits and other support.

When food insecurity became a real concern, we provided her with grocery cards, giving her the flexibility to put food on the table and keep the electricity on.

Today, Sabrina still faces challenges, but she no longer wakes up paralyzed by fear.

Because of you, she knows she is not alone, and a family that was on the brink is still standing – together.

Through His Mother's Eyes: A Transformation at St. Charles

For five years, Kelly tried everything to make the public school system work for her son.

But Michael, then a fifth-grader, was reading at approximately a first-grade level. He was struggling academically and exhibiting behaviors that were difficult to manage in a traditional classroom setting.

Eventually, the school agreed he needed something different.

That is when Kelly discovered St. Charles School. Based in Rochester, the Catholic Charities NH program provides specialized education and support for children facing behavioral and emotional challenges.

During their tour, Michael formed an immediate connection with Principal Tom Hayward. By the end of the visit, he didn't even want to see the second school they had planned to tour.

"For the first time, my son had people who were truly on his side – people who genuinely wanted to help him succeed," Kelly shared. "Seeing how they met my son where he was, without judgment and with no other goal than helping him grow, made my heart swell."

In just three years, Michael went from reading at approximately a first-grade level to performing at grade level as an eighth grader. He developed healthy coping skills, built meaningful friendships, gained confidence, and even took on leadership roles within the school.

St. Charles supported not only Michael, but his entire family during one of the most difficult periods of their lives.

"The staff at St. Charles saw us at our worst – struggling emotionally, financially, and personally – and never once judged us," Kelly said. "Instead, they quietly stepped in to help."

This spring, Michael graduated from St. Charles and is preparing to enter high school.

"They didn't just educate my son," Kelly shared. "They changed the course of his life."

Michael was among **32 students supported by St. Charles** this past year, gaining the skills and confidence to reach their potential both inside and outside the classroom.

You Helped Tammy Not Once – But Twice

Tammy was 16 – pregnant, alone, and with no one to rely on.

After being kicked out of her family’s home, she found herself living in a small Manchester apartment. She worked at McDonald’s to make ends meet, but raising a baby on her own at 16 was overwhelming.

That’s when Tammy first found Catholic Charities NH through the Our Place program.

There, she learned how to care for her newborn and gained the support and confidence she needed as a young mother.

“They were angels on Earth,” she shares.

Tammy went on to raise three children while building a career in customer service and administration. But at age 43, everything changed again.

Tammy suffered a catastrophic stroke that left her partially paralyzed and unable to eat or care for herself. She spent two months in and out of hospitals and rehabilitation centers as she learned how to live with the effects of her stroke.

Her marriage ended, friends drifted away, and everyday tasks like getting groceries became almost impossible.

While watching television early one morning, Tammy saw a commercial that brought her back to Catholic Charities NH. That’s when she learned about the CareGivers program.

Today, CareGivers provides Tammy with transportation to medical appointments and monthly grocery deliveries, helping her maintain the independence she fought hard to regain after her stroke. But for Tammy, the greatest gift is the human connection.

Tammy spends many days by herself, except for her rescue dog, Mr. Big. That makes each visit mean even more.

“When someone pulls up happy to see me, I feel like a million dollars,” she says.

Tammy now lives independently and treasures quality time with her family.

At 16, Catholic Charities NH helped her believe in her future. Decades later, when life changed in an instant, you reminded her that she didn’t have to face it alone.

Visitors explored firsthand accounts from Catholic Charities staff and volunteers across the country, stepped into an interactive poverty simulation, and learned more about the realities facing families here in New Hampshire.

By sharing stories and inspiring action, the museum reminded our community that hope begins with neighbors helping neighbors – including amazing people like you.



A Year of Recognition for Senior Care

Our skilled nursing and rehabilitation communities were once again honored for excellence in care for older adults across New Hampshire!

- Mt. Carmel, St. Teresa, St. Ann, St. Francis, and Warde Senior Living were named 2026 recipients of the Bronze – Commitment to Quality Award by the American Health Care Association and National Center for Assisted Living (AHCA/NCAL).
- St. Ann, St. Francis, St. Teresa, Warde Senior Living, and St. Vincent de Paul received a 2026 Customer Experience Award from Activated Insights, with each ranking within the top 15% of care providers nationwide over the past 12 months in key customer service and operational areas.
- St. Teresa and St. Joseph Residence were both named among the nation's top providers of long-term care by U.S. News & World Report. Warde Senior Living was named among the top providers of short-term rehabilitation.

80 Years of Hope, One Unforgettable Night

Catholic Charities NH celebrated 80 years of serving New Hampshire in style! Vose Farm Residences Opens Its Doors

Our first affordable workforce housing community is open! Vose Farm Residences in Peterborough offers 64 new one- and two-bedroom apartments for individuals, families, and older adults earning 50–60% of the area median income, along with five market-rate units. On-site supportive services help residents achieve long-term stability and success.

Created to address the state’s growing housing shortage, Vose Farm reflects our commitment to ensuring more Granite Staters have access to safe, stable, and affordable housing.

New Gen Earns the State’s First Top Gun Award

New Generation was named the state’s top shelter with the inaugural Top Gun Award from the New Hampshire Bureau of Homeless Services, recognizing exceptional success in helping mothers and children overcome homelessness. The Catholic Charities NH program earned top rankings in bed utilization, benefits enrollment, and helping families increase their income before leaving the program.

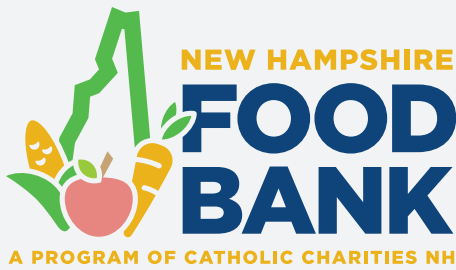
FY2026 Sources of Funds
